Fly Fishing - Iceland, Tungufljot 4.-8.9.2022

Fly fishing for salmon on Tungufljot river in Iceland. Fishmaster will arrange a hosted fly fishing trip to the Tungufljot on 4th-8th September 2022. Jouni Rauha works as a host for this fly fishing trip. The Tungufljot is one of the most beautiful rivers located in southern Iceland 100 km South-East from Reykjavik.



Tungufljot. The Tungufljot is one of the most attractive salmon rivers in Iceland. It's a large/medium size river that originates in the southern highlands and joins the mighty Hvíta. It winds it's way down to the lowlands through spectacular canyons and opens up on the lower pools, with breathtaking scenery wherever you look. The salmon makes it's way up through the vast Hvita/Ölfusa river system, the largest river system in Iceland, before reaching Tungufljot – far inland.



The natural surroundings are spectacular, the river itself is a dramatic combination of gravel-flats and waterfalls and gorges, ensuring the variety of pools fished are great. You will find calm pools as well as fast flowing ones. Access is very good and most pools are accessible by regular sedans or smaller 4x4 vehicles. Tungufljot average catch for the last years is about 250-300 salmon per season.



Fly Fishing. The fishing beat on the Tungufljot river is about 3 km long and 2 rods fish the West bank below Faxi falls and 2 rods on the East bank. 2 rods fish above the falls. The beat includes the famous Faxi falls pool. We have booked 2 rods of the West bank below falls and 2 rods above falls for our Fishmaster group. There is also possibility to share a rod with another angler, by sharing a rod price per person will be more reasonable.



We will arrange a rotation fly fishing where beats will be rotated every 3 hours between anglers. split the beat in two 2 rods beats, upper and lower beat. Daily fishing hours in September are from 7.00 until 13.00 and again from 15.00 to 21.00. The fishing season is from June 24th until the 30th September.

Flies. Good flies for the Tungufljot river salmon are for example Blue & Black, Black Sheep, Silver Sheep, Frances, Snaelda, Blue Charm, Allys Shrimp, Sunray Shadow.

Fly Fishing Tackle. For fly fishing for salmon on the Tungufljot we recommend 12-14' double handed rods for lines 8-10 and suitable fly reels with good quality brakes. You can also fish with 9-10 feet single handed rod for lines 7-8. Sink tip or intermediate shooting heads are most used fly lines. It is mandatory to have your fishing gear disinfected on arrival at Keflavík international airport customs.



Accommodation. At the Tungufljot we have rented 2 nice cottages close to the beat each with 2 bedrooms, shower, toilet, jacuzzi, equipped kitchen and a comfortable livingroom. We will cook the meals in accomodation.



Travel Arrangements. A hosted Fishmaster fly fishing trip. Jouni Rauha works as a host for this trip. Guests will take an interational flight to Reykjavik Keflavik airport and continue with rental car to the Tungufljot river. It's about two hours driving from Keflavik airport to the Tungufljot.



Trip length: 3 and half fishing days/4 nights

Group size: 1 host + 3-5 persons

Price includes: Accomodation, Fly fishing, Fishing licenses, Introduction of beat

Price excludes: Flights to/from Reykjavik Keflavik, Disinfection (30-40 eur/person), Meals, Rental car

Fish species: Salmon, Arctic Char



Travel Arrangements. Fishing trips to Iceland, Tungufljot River are hosted trips. Anglers will take a flight to Keflavik airport. At the airport they will meet host Jouni Rauha and continue to the Tungufljot with 2 rental cars, it is about 2 hours drive.

General information. Please book flights for yourself according to flight schedule recommendations. We try to avoid too long waiting at the Keflavik airport. After you have booked your flights, give the flight numbers and schedules for Fishmaster/Jouni Rauha by e-mail: jouni@fishmaster.fi. Take with the tackle listed. Please pack the luggage into a big soft bag, it's easier to back them into a rental car.



Rental Car, Meals. Host Jouni Rauha will book a small SUV rental car for himself and one of the 3 clients will book a medium size SUV rental car for rest of the group. Clients will share the rental and fuel costs of car.

Trip Schedule

4.9. Sunday. Gathering at the Keflavik airport. Meeting the host Jouni Rauha and other anglers at the airport. Visit at Tax Free shop and disinfection of fishing gear. Pick up 2 rental cars at the airport. Rental car transport from airport to the Tungufljot River. Moving in to 2 nice cottages close to Tungufljot. Dinner in the cottages.

5.-7.9. Monday-Wednesday. Breakfast at 6:00. Fly fishing for salmon on the Tungufljot River. Daily fishing hours in September are from 7:00 until 13:00, changing the beats at 10:00. Lunch break 13-15. Fly fishing continues from 15:00 to 21:00, changing the beats at 18:00.

8.9. Thursday. Breakfast at 6:00. Fly fishing for salmon on the Tungufljot 7:00-12:00. Changing beats at 9:30. Leaving the cottages at 13:00 and heading back to Reykjavik with rental car. Jouni will stay at Tungufljot. Flight back home with an afternoon flight or alternatively stay overnight in hotel in Reykjavik or Keflavik.
