Fly Fishing - Iceland, Sog 11-15.9.2019

Fly fishing for salmon on Sog River in Iceland. Fishmaster will arrange a hosted fly fishing trip to the Sog Asgardur Beat on 11th-15th September 2019. Jouni Rauha works as a host for this fly fishing trip. Sog is a beautiful river located in southern Iceland 80 km South-East from Reykjavik.

Sog. The Sog is one of the most attractive salmon rivers in Iceland. It's a large size river that originates in the southern highlands and joins the mighty Hvíta. It winds it's way down to the lowlands through spectacular landscape and opens up on the lower pools, with breathtaking scenery wherever you look.

The salmon makes it's way up through the vast Hvita/Ölfusa river system, the largest river system in Iceland, before reaching Sog. The natural surroundings are spectacular, ensuring the variety of pools fished are great. You will find calm pools as well as fast flowing ones. Access is very good and most pools are accessible by regular sedans or smaller 4x4 vehicles. Sog Asgardur beat's average catch for last years is 200-300 salmon per season.

Fly Fishing. The Sog River Asgardur beat is 5,6 km long and consists of the North/Left bank of the river. We have booked all 3 rods of the West bank for our Fishmaster group of 6 persons. Daily fishing hours in September are from 7.00 until 13.00 and again from 15.00 to 21.00. The fishing season is from June 24th until the 24th September. All caught salmon must be released and only fly fishing is allowed for this trip.

Flies. Good flies for the Sog River are for example Blue & Black, Black Sheep, Silver Sheep, Frances, Snaelda, Blue Charm, Sunray Shadow and Willie Gunn.

Fly Fishing Tackle. For fly fishing for salmon on the Sog we recommend 13-15' double handed rods for lines 8-10 and suitable fly reels with good quality brakes. Sink tip or intermediate shooting heads are most used fly lines. It is mandatory to have your fishing gear disinfected on arrival at Keflavík international airport.

Accomodation. At Asgardur beat there is a nice self catering lodge with 3 twin bedrooms, shower, toilet, well-equipped kitchen, a comfortable livingroom and a Jacuzzi. We will cook the food together in lodge and share the costs between all group members.



Travel Arrangements. Hosted Fishmaster fishing trip. Jouni Rauha works as a host for this trip. Guests will take an interational flight to Reykjavik, Keflavik airport and continue with rental car to the Sog River. It's about 2 hours driving from Keflavik airport to the Sog.

Trip length: 3 fishing days/4 nights

Group size: 1 host + 2-5 persons fishing with 3 rods

Price includes: Accomodation, Fishing licenses, Introduction of beat

Price excludes: Flights to Reykjavik, Disinfection (30-40 eur/person), Meals, Rental car

Travel Arrangements. Fishing trips to Iceland, Tungufljot River are always hosted trips. Anglers will take flight to Keflavik airport. At the airport they will meet host Jouni Rauha and continue to the Tungufljot by rental car, it is about one and half hours drive.

General information. Please book the flights for yourself according to flight schedule recommendations. We try to avoid too long waiting at the Keflavik airport. After you have booked your flights, give the flight numbers and schedules for Fishmaster/Jouni Rauha by e-mail: jouni@fishmaster.fi. Take with the tackle listed. Please pack the luggage into a big soft bag, it's easier to back them into a rental car.




Trip Schedule

11.9. Wednesday. Gathering at the Keflavik airport in the afternoon. Meeting the Fishmaster host Jouni Rauha and other anglers at the airport. Visit at the Tax Free shop and disinfection of fishing gear. Rental car transport from Keflavik airport to the Sog River. Moving in to the Sog Asgardur Lodge and introduction of the beat. Dinner in the lodge.

12-14.9. Thursday-Saturday. Fly fishing for salmon on the Sog River at the Asgardur beat. Breakfasts, lunches and dinner at the lodge. Daily fishing hours in September are from 7.00 until 13.00 and again from 15.00 to 21.00.

15.9. Sunday. Leaving the lodge accomodation early in the morning at 4.00 and heading back to the Keflavik airport with rental car. 6.00 arrival to the Keflavik airport, returning the rental car. Flight back home according to everyone's flight schedules.
